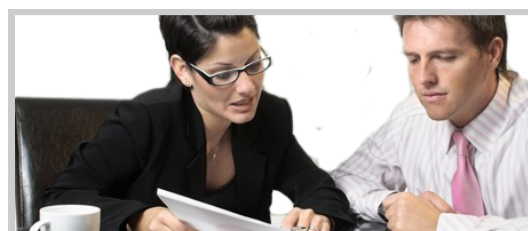


Start Your Own Business FETAC Level 5

Participants may wish to apply for exemption from parts of this programme based on prior learning experience, valid and reliable evidence will need to be provided.
Duration: This programme will run for 5 contact days and will require participants to complete some work in their own time.	Who should attend this course: People interested in owning their own business.
Required fluency in generic skills such as literacy/numeracy/interpersonal skills: Participants entering onto this programme will usually be proficient at reading, drafting, preparing and understanding information across a broad range of topics, solve predictable problems well independently and as part of a group.	
FETAC Assessment: Participants who wish to achieve a FETAC Component Certificate must complete a Project (100%).
