Tips

- Tip for fighting a cold: Gargling can moisten a sore throat and bring temporary relief. Try a teaspoon of salt dissolved in warm water, four times daily. To reduce the tickle in your throat, try an astringent gargle -- such as tea that contains tannin -- to tighten the membranes.
- Food Hygiene Tip: Cross contamination is one of the most common causes of food poisoning. It happens when harmful bacteria are spread onto food from other food, surfaces, hands or equipment. These bacteria often come from raw meat/poultry and eggs. So it is especially important to handle these foods carefully.
