### Tips

- **How to change tap head/washer** Isolate the taps you want to change. Remove the top of the head. Spray the insert with WD40 and leave for 10 min. Using the right size spanner remove the insert by turning anti clockwise. Remove old rubber washer and fit new one or use replacement head. Replace insert into tap and tighten with the spanner by turning it clockwise. Turn water back on and test.
- Turn your **refrigerator** down. Refrigerators account for about 20% of Household electricity use. Use a thermometer to set your refrigerator temperature as close to 37 degrees and your freezer as close to 3 degrees as possible. Make sure that its energy saver switch is turned on. Also, check the gaskets around your refrigerator/freezer doors to make sure they are clean and sealed tightly.
